

My dear Governor Jordan:

Pursuant to Public Law 572, approved July 16, 1952, I have appointed Mr. Frank A. Banks to be the Federal representative to participate in the negotiation by the States of Idaho, Montana, Oregon, Washington, and Wyoming, of a compact for the equitable division and apportionment of the waters of the Columbia River, and all its tributaries in the States named, and for other purposes, and to report to the Congress on those proceedings and on any compact entered into by the States.
